

## **Directions to Knobs Haven from Cincinnati and Lexington**

Take **I-75 SOUTH** toward Lexington.

After you pass Georgetown KY and pass the exit for I-64 West, be looking for **EXIT 115 OFF I-75 (RTE 922)**. You will see a small sign indicating that Exit 115 leads to the Bluegrass (BG) Parkway, as well as to the airport.

**GO RIGHT ON RTE. 922 TO 4 WEST.** Stay on Rte 922 for just under 2 miles.

**TAKE 4 WEST TO EXIT 5B, OR RTE. 60 WEST.** Stay on Rte 60 for about 5 miles.

**MERGE RIGHT ONTO THE BLUEGRASS PARKWAY.** Travel about 30 miles.

**TAKE THE EXIT FOR SPRINGFIELD, EXIT 42 – RTE. 555.**

At the end of the exit ramp, **TURN LEFT (SOUTH) TOWARDS SPRINGFIELD.**

On Rte 555, after about 14 miles, you'll encounter 3 traffic lights.

**TURN RIGHT AT THE 3<sup>RD</sup> TRAFFIC LIGHT, ONTO RTE 150**, where a McDonald's restaurant will be on your right. (Note that this is the second time you'll intersect Rte 150.) Proceed about 1 mile further.

**TURN LEFT ONTO RTE 152.** (There is a Southern States building on the right at this junction.) Stay on Rte 152 for almost 10 miles. At that point, you'll see a road sign for the Sisters of Loretto, as well as a stone sign about 50 feet off to the right that says "Loretto Motherhouse," and the entrance.

**TURN RIGHT INTO THE MOTHERHOUSE DRIVE.** (If you miss the Motherhouse drive, you'll come to a stop sign and intersection with Rte 49, and will know that you've gone ½ mile too far.) Proceed up the Motherhouse driveway.

**a) IF YOU KNOW THE RETREAT AREA WHERE YOU'LL BE STAYING, you may go directly there.**

**b) IF YOU DO NOT KNOW THE RETREAT AREA WHERE YOU'LL BE STAYING:**

**AT THE TOP OF THE HILL, CONTINUE STRAIGHT** on the driveway (even though the directional sign says that Knobs Haven is to the left). The road will curve to the right, and shortly you'll see a small parking lot, with a sign that points to the "Main Office." Park your car, and enter the double doors to the main office. Tell the receptionist that you're here for retreat. She'll contact someone to come greet you and take you to the place where you'll be staying.
